

NEW AND MODIFIED EVENTS

- Motion for Entry of Clerk's Default** - **New event created 8/12/04**
This event is to request a Clerk's Entry of Default and is located under the Adversary/Motions category.
- Report of Property Abandoned at 341 Meeting** - **New event created 8/12/04**
This event is primarily for creditors who obtain the trustee's abandonment of property of the estate during the 341(a) Meeting of Creditors. The event is located under the Miscellaneous category.
- Modified Chapter 13 Plan (after confirmation)** - **New event created 8/12/04**
Prior to confirmation of a Chapter 13 Plan, please use the "Amended Chapter 13 Plan" events located. After the plan has been confirmed, attorneys should use the "Modified Chapter 13 Plan" event in order to modify a confirmed plan.
- Motion for Approval of Reaffirmation Agreement** - **Event removed from list on 6/16/04**
A Motion for Approval of Reaffirmation Agreement should not be filed and, in most circumstances, will not be heard by the Court in that approval is not generally necessary except when a case is filed by *Pro Se* debtors.
- Motion for Authority to Use Tax Refund** - **New event created 6/4/04**
This event can be found under the *Motions* category as well as the trustee category. A text box appears for you include additional information.
- Motion for Authority to Use Property of Estate** - **New event created 6/4/04**
This event can be found under the *Motions* category. A text box appears for you to add a description of the property.
- Motion to Continue Meeting of Creditors** - **Event removed from list on 6/2/04**
A Motion to Continue Meeting of Creditors should not be filed and will not be granted by the Court. A request to continue 341 Meeting of Creditors should be submitted to the appropriate trustee.
- Motion to Withdraw Document** - **Event modified on 5/25/04**
The event "Withdraw Document" under the *Motions* category has been modified in appearance. The event now reads "Withdraw Document - Motion to Withdraw Document." This event is considered a motion and will require a Proposed Order. The change was made to distinguish it from the "Withdraw Document" event under the *Miscellaneous* category which does not require a Proposed Order.
