
IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that due to hurricane related damage and destruction, the Pensacola Office of the Bankruptcy Court for the Northern District of Florida is officially closed Tuesday, September 14, 2004 through and including Monday, September 27, 2004.

As a result of the catastrophic impact Hurricane Ivan has had on the area's infrastructure, (i.e. power outages, interrupted telephone service, impassable roadways, and extensive water intrusion), the Pensacola bar's ability to function and serve clients has been severely impaired.

THEREFORE, IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that deadlines and Chapter 13 plan payments for Pensacola cases falling between the period of Tuesday, September 14, 2004, through Tuesday, October 12, 2004, are herein extended until the close of business, Tuesday, October 12, 2004. All documents filed or Chapter 13 plan payments made by October 12, 2004, in response to deadlines that occurred within the disaster recovery period will be deemed timely.

If additional time is required due to extenuating circumstances related to the hurricane, these will be considered on a case-by-case basis upon properly filed motion.
