

**INVITATION FOR PUBLIC COMMENT
PROPOSED LOCAL CHAPTER 13 PLAN FORM**

Amendments to the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure approved by the Supreme Court and transmitted to Congress on April 27, 2017 become effective December 1, 2017. Bankruptcy Rule 3015(c) requires the use of an Official Form (National Chapter 13 Plan) unless a district instead adopts a Local Form plan that meets the requirements of Bankruptcy Rule 3015.1.

This Court's Chapter 13 *Ad Hoc* Committee unanimously voted against the use of the National Chapter 13 plan form and has drafted a proposed local Chapter 13 Plan: [FLNB LF 13-21 Eff. 12/1/17](#).

Members of the Bar and the public are invited to comment on this district's proposed Local Chapter 13 plan form.

The public comment period begins on Friday, June 16 and ends at the close of business on Monday, July 17. Please submit comments in writing to the following address:
