## Case Opening, the NEF, and Attorney/Party Association

### Case Opening - Multiple SSN/ITINs & Tax ID/EINs

When opening a new bankruptcy case, filers will have the ability to add up to five (5) Social Security and/or Tax ID Numbers for each debtor. Once you begin entering the SSN/ITIN or Tax Id/EIN number, a plus sign (+) will appear to the right of the text field. Clicking this icon will open an additional text field.

### Case Opening - Repeat Filers

During the case opening process, ECF will compare the debtor's identification numbers with those already in our system (Northern District of Florida only). If it appears that the debtor has filed a prior case within the last eight (8) years, the case number is displayed with a hyperlink to the docket sheet for verification.

CM/ECF will automatically set the "Prior filings within last 8 years" flag to "Yes" in cases where the debtor has a previous filing in this district. Case upload has been reconfigured to perform this search and automatic functionality as well.

### The Notice of Electronic Filing (NEF)

In prior releases, when an attorney represented more than one party in a case, the attorney's email and party information were listed on the Notice of Electronic Filing (NEF) only for the first party. Now the attorney is listed for each party they represent.

**Although an attorney may be listed multiple times on an NEF, the system will not send multiple emails.**

### Attorney/Party Association

Currently when an attorney or trustee files a pleading, they are prompted to indicate whether they should be linked to the party they represent. The checkbox for the association with the attorney and party was unchecked and if the filer does not check the box, the association is not made.

With the upgrade to Release 5/5.1, the checkbox for the association with the attorney and party will now be checked by default. A new message has been added to reflect the implications of omitting this necessary association.

**If the box is unchecked, the attorney will not be added to the case for noticing or shown in queries nor will the attorney appear on or receive the Notice of Electronic Filing.**
