ORDER

Before: The Executive Committee of the Judicial Council acting on behalf of the Judicial Council.

The Honorable Paul G. Hyman Jr., having consented to serve and Chief United States District Judge Cecilia M. Altonaga having consented to such service, is hereby RECALLED for service as a United States Bankruptcy Judge assigned to the Southern, Middle, and Northern Districts of Florida upon the expiration of his current term on January 3, 2024. Bankruptcy Judge Hyman will serve primarily in West Palm Beach, Florida but is authorized to serve at all locations at which the Southern, Middle, and Northern Districts of Florida conduct court.

This recall is pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 375 and the Five-Year Recall Regulations promulgated by the Judicial Conference of the United States in Volume 3, Chapter 16 of the *Guide to Judiciary Policy*. Bankruptcy Judge Hyman is authorized to perform the powers and duties of the office of bankruptcy judge as provided by law and by the district court.

The Judicial Council certifies that Bankruptcy Judge Hyman is expected to perform substantial service during the period of recall. The recall is subject to an annual certification by the Chief District Judge and the Judicial Council that substantial work exists for him to perform. Bankruptcy Judge Hyman's appointment shall be in effect on January 4, 2024, and shall continue in effect until and including January 3, 2029.

No staff support or reimbursable travel was requested for Bankruptcy Judge Hyman, and none is authorized.
