

*The 31-day search restriction on the Cases Report does not apply when searching by "Months without a confirmed plan."




Calendar Reports

Viewers will be able to generate this report with both date and time increments (vs. the current date-to-date only).



Query

PACER customers requested additional search functionality be added to the Bankruptcy Query screen. The Release 5 query screen presents options for Filed Date range and Last Entry Date range which can be very helpful when looking for recent updates or filings. The adversary and miscellaneous proceeding Nature of Suit codes have also been added, as well as a link to the new Mobile Query.



Be advised that selection of a Nature of Suit code as your only search criteria could produce many records and result in a large PACER billing charge. You will be required to consent to this possibility prior to completing the search.

Please note the warning message displayed at the top of the screens when generating reports as many reports are *not* subject to the 30-page limit and may result in large PACER billing charges.

Mobile Query

Release 5 introduces a new mobile query feature that streamlines the basic CM/ECF search when using portable devices. This interface is reformatted for easier viewing on smaller screens. Mobile Query is compatible with smart phones such as the iPhone, Android, BlackBerrys, and other PDAs that can access web applications, and is designed to work on any browser that can support basic HTML. Standard PACER charges will apply.

Mobile Query can search by case number, party name, or keyword(s) in docket text within a case. When searching spaces can be used instead of other punctuation such as a dash or comma. You must enter at least two letters of the last name when searching by name. You can access Mobile Query within CM/ECF whether on

a computer or mobile device.



When viewing the docket in larger cases it may be helpful to search by keyword(s) if you are searching for a particular pleading. You may do this by clicking the magnifying glass icon and typing the word(s) you seek.

The U.S. Bankruptcy Court for the Northern District of Florida will upgrade to CM/ECF Release 5.1, incorporating the changes from Release 5.0, the weekend of April 26-28, 2013. During that time, the system will be unavailable. We will notify you via email as soon as the system becomes available.
